Youth Sports Programs Team Assignment and Selections

- Coach's children will be placed on the same team as their parents.
- Siblings will be placed on the same team if they are in the same age group unless parent would like them on separate teams.
- We will try to honor requests as long as the balance of equitable teams is not compromised.
