

Colored Salt



Supplies Needed:

- Table Salt
- Food Coloring
- Recycled Jars
- Gold Spray Paint (Optional if you want to spray the jar lids)
- Resealable Bags



Instructions:

- 1 - Start by cleaning out your recycled jars and remove any labels.
 - You can soak labels in soapy water and they should come off
- 2 - Pour 1 Cup of Salt into a resealable bag.
- 3 - Add a little bit of Food Coloring to start
 - Don't add too much coloring or it will make the salt too wet and clumpy. If you need a little more coloring just add a little bit more at a time to avoid it getting too wet.
 - If the salt is too wet, the colors may bleed in the jars.
Start small and add more coloring slowly.
- 4 - Shake resealable bag to combine Salt and Food Coloring
 - If any clumps form, scoop them out or keep mixing to try to combine.
- 5 - Now you are ready to start creating your jars. Use a funnel and small spoons, have kids add different colors into the jars. You can layer any color combinations you'd like or make a rainbow version!
- 6 - Keep filling the jars to the top. Some of the salt may settle so it is best to fill the jar to the top in case this happens. If you still have some settle, add more salt into the jar after one day.
- 7 - Now your jars are finished! These would make great gift!
